

You should have the info and link for the Storm Game ticket sales and more. For those of you who are new to the process, here are a few FAQ's.

Do the cheerleaders need tickets? Yes. Everyone must have a ticket, including cheerleaders and coaches. We are asking that everyone sell at least 8 tickets (that includes your own!)

What if we don't sell 8 tickets? To have the fun opportunities we get to have at the Storm game, we make a commitment to sell a large block of tickets. It's an average of 8 tickets each for the program. If you don't sell 8, then hope that someone sells more than 8. Unfortunately we cut it pretty close a few years ago, so we really need everyone to work hard to sell at least 8 tickets. You can sell tickets to family, friends, coworkers, anyone! If we're unable to perform we will get refunded, but that would be very sad!

What if we sell more than 8 tickets? The top 4 ticket sellers get to be Honorary Captains at the game. The Honorary Captains get to go down to the court before the game, sit on the Storm bench and watch warm-up, and they get to meet the Storm captains and the opposing team captains and get a basketball autographed by the captains!

The next top 10 ticket sellers will have the opportunity to go down on the court when the players are introduced and each will get an autographed ball tossed to them by one of the players. It is an amazing experience--and you get to keep the autographed ball!

Can we share the link with other people? Unlike our other games, this link is just for EDE cheerleaders. We get physical tickets for Storm so it keeps things streamlined if every cheerleader just places ONE ticket order for all their family and friends.

What time do we need to be at the game, and how does it work when we get there? Everyone will need to arrive by 6:00pm at Climate Pledge Arena on May 22nd. We will meet at Section 7 outside the Modelo Bar. We will have instructions there as to when/where to meet for warm-up.

We will not all be seated together--we are usually spread out over a few sections. At the appointed time all the cheerleaders will need to meet to go downstairs to our warm-up area. Parents are NOT allowed in the warm-up area as this area is closed to the public. We will be facing section 14 when we perform so parents are welcome to move as needed to that area to watch from the front.

After the performance the cheerleaders will come back up to Section 7 and meet parents there. Give us a few minutes to make sure everyone has the right poms. Cheerleaders will then be released to parents to enjoy the rest of the game or leave.
